Late Summer

- Cascade Delight - Late (July)
- Tulameen - Late (long season)

CANEBERRIES (Order of Ripening)

Loganberries - Early
Boysenberries - Mid-Season
Thornless Boysenberries - Mid-Season (May to June)
Marionberries - Mid-Season (July)
Tayberries - Mid-Season
Blackberries

- Chester - August - September
- Kiowa - June - for about 6 weeks
- Chester Thornless - Late (August to September)
- Apache - Late June
