How to Place Fish Into Your Pond or Aquarium

1. Transport your fish home as soon as possible. Keep the bag out of the sunlight.
2. When you arrive home, float the bag with the fish in the pond or aquarium for 10 minutes to allow the fish to acclimate to the new water temperature.
3. Add Stress Coat to the pond water as this will help add additional slime coating to the fish. It will also block chlorine from coming into contact with the fish.
4. After 10 minutes, it is safe to release your fish into the pond.
5. We recommend that you do not put the water from the bag into your pond.
6. Instead, empty the bag into a net (trapping the fish) and then lower the fish into the pond.
7. Tsugawa's offers a 24 hour fish guarantee. You must return the fish and your receipt.
