# How to Handle Fish

1. When netting fish, only use the blue bowls that are marked for the tank you are netting from.
2. Never put your hands into the water or touch the fish with your bare hands.
3. If netting from more than one tank, use a different net or dip the net in the solution.
4. Place fish in blue bowls and have the customer make his/her selection.
5. Put enough water in a bag of the right size. Place fish in bag.
6. Put one bag buddy tablet into the bag.
7. Insert the air nozzle into the bag.
8. Fill bag  $\frac{3}{4}$  full with air and twist top closed and secure with a rubber band.
9. Fish should remain in bag for only  $\frac{3}{4}$  to 1 hour. If they need to be in the bag longer, you should use a larger bag so that more air can be inserted.
10. Place the fish and bag in a box for support.
11. Put nets back into the sterile bucket and empty the blue bowls.
12. Fill out a write-up slip with the correct price.
13. Have customer take fish to cashier desk to pay.
14. REMEMBER – Always recommend STRESS Coat.
