PERENNIALS FOR THE COTTAGE GARDEN

The perennials in a cottage garden are old-fashioned, informal and fragrant. There should be no symmetrical rows of plants or careful arrangement to spoil the patchwork effect. Annuals are set amidst the vegetables, herbs and perennials. Berry plants grow in clumps instead of orderly rows.

CARE: Poor soils will need to be amended with Black Forest Soil Conditioner and a good fertilizer such as Dr. Earth. Fertilizer application (preferably organic) should be in early spring and again after the first flush of blooms

LIGHT: Most perennials prefer full sun to light shade. If they do not receive enough light, they will become leggy and fall over. Shade tolerant perennials are marked with an asterisk(*).
